2 Dye 4

It was 1986, the skate look of bleach blonde bangs was the peek of fashion. @ least amongst middle school students in eastern Pennsylvania. I was 10 years old & I still remember crawling up into the chair @ the salon & telling the stylist just how I wanted it. That was one of the last times I saw my natural hair color. If memory serves it was a sandy ash brown but the bleached blonde bangs worked so well I decided to just go blonde altogether & then I went through every shade of blonde imaginable. Everyone's heard that "blondes have more fun" but take it from someone who's been there, it's not exactly the truth. Most people assume if you're blonde that you dye your hair, & if you don't touch it up every week your roots will confirm their suspicions. It's a fun look for summer though, light and playful, especially if you have a naturally lighter shade, the sun can cut down your time between touch ups drastically!

It took me close to 4 years to go through every blonde & brown before I got completely bored & discovered RED! There are definitely pluses & minuses to the fiery tones. Most guys have something for red heads, it gives off the impression of attitude, & an easy color to pull off once you find the shade that works best for you. There are many different types of red, from a deep auburn to an intense orange to a strawberry blonde; it's an easy way for people to express themselves in a "normal" colorful way. The key to making reds look natural is finding a way to tint your eyebrows to match. THIS CAN BE VERY DANDEROUS! The way I do it is by rubbing the slightest amount of excess dye across my brows with the tip of my rubber glove & then after 5 or 10 minutes remove it by wiping it clean with a next to dry wash cloth. This is only for the boldest & the bravest. The skin around your eyes is very sensitive & prone to irritation. A little burning is natural the first couple of times you do it or the harsher the dye is. Extreme care must always be taken not to drip because if the dye gets in your eye you probably will go blind. Is it

tacky Sean Young looked after my blonde from brunette makeover in *A Kiss Before Dying* I decided it was worth it to me, but I've been doing it for years & have much experience. I started dying my hair when I was about 13 as opposed to going to the salon. The difference? \$60+, especially if you shop at Sally's, then the dye's even the same, where do you think your stylist gets it from? By the time I was 16 I was dying my hair every couple of weeks to a month, changing the shade over & over I'd exhausted every natural shade, except black - I always knew better than to go there (you can't go back). From the red, it was easy to make the transition into purple. There are almost as many shades of purple available as there are red (& yes I went through those too!). The good thing about purple is that it keeps its intensity a little longer than the red that tends to fade to a general coppery color after a while if not properly maintained. Be careful though a red based purple (or blonde) vs. the violet, blue, or ash base will give you the same effect as the red dyes when bleaching or stripping the color from your hair. Instead of taking your hair down to a neutral blonde or white, it turns it a light shade of orange. I learned about bleaching when I learned about extreme color & my addiction to it. Believe it or not even purple started to seem like a normal color & I began to move through the rest of the rainbow. Blue, red, yellow, fluorescent pink, green, teared as my grandma called it. A nightmare is what the hair stylist my mom hired this year (as she does every year) to "fix it" called it. He asked, "Why couldn't you have @ least done it with some sort of rhyme or reason?" & I had to lay it out to him. I've done almost every color in almost every pattern, the only way to get something new is to randomly throw bleach & dye on my hair & just see how it turns out. One time last year when everyone was trying to guess what color it would be next I dyed it brown just to throw them all off. I can't keep it that way for long; a "normal" color for me just isn't normal. I get depressed. When your hair's a strange color it speaks for itself, you don't even have to style it if you don't feel like it & it gives any stranger an opportunity for a conversation starter. The best thing though, is the way little children

have blue hair naturally. It's great! So if you're thinking about letting your true color shine through take a tip from someone who's been around the color wheel, a couple of times!

Tips 4 Your Tips

- Use Manic Panic or Special Effects for extreme colors you want to last
- N Rage semi perm-antent is good for washing out quick
- Punky Color is good if you want a color other than the one on the bottle that either washes out quick or holds on forever, you never know
- Extreme colors last longest if you pre treat your hair w/ some sort of color first
- If you strip your hair to much it will fall out
- Always condition afterwards

Edible Play Dough

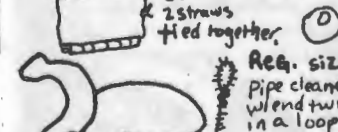
- 1 c. flour

Driving is Driving me Crazy!

When the ancient Romans started construction of the first roads, did they ever suspect that things would turn out the way they have? Just picture Caesar's chariot stuck in traffic in the down town tunnel @ rush hour or faced with some of the massive thoroughfares that litter the metropolises of the modern world. They probably would have stuck dirt roads, or even regressed to traveling on foot. Major traffic accidents, road rage, car jacking, hour-long delays, pollution, drunk drivers, have we forgotten that driving is a privilege not a right. And even though it seems like you're the only one out there who didn't get their drivers license @ Kmart I'm sure there are a few common courtesies even a professional such as yourself could brush up on. Driving is not about reaching your destination the fastest, or cruising along enjoying the scenery. It's a symphony, it has movement, & a tempo. Everyone on the road plays a different part in the orchestration & if even one person is out of sync it can throw the entire movement off. The key to this is of course the very first thing they teach you in driver's ed. PAY ATTENTION to the road. And full attention works best. People today want to see how many different things they can do at once. How often do you see someone speeding down the road paying more attention to the conversation on their cel phone than the person braking in front of them. I've even seen people driving & reading @ the



same time! How can you be looking @ the road when you're looking @ a book? If your test was THAT important you would have studied last night. TURN SIGNALS are not optional, use them. They are the law you know. Know that when the government sets the SPEED LIMIT they set it 10 miles slower than they really expect you to go, so in order to keep the pace you should always go @ least 5 miles over the posted speed. In most states tickets under 9 miles over are automatically dismissed from court anyway, but it can give an officer a reason to stop you if he suspects something else might be up. When you come to a GREEN LIGHT, go! If you get caught by a YELLOW LIGHT go through it. If you're turning left know that three cars should always make it through after the light changes. At a RED LIGHT, stop! Duh. A TURNING LANE should only be used for turning. This includes turning left into the turn lane before merging right into traffic. If someone is turning into your lane & you can let them in, why not? Otherwise try to get in the other lane so they have the room to merge safely. Don't try to jump in a lane when only one car is coming, wait until they go by, then pass them. Don't tail gate, don't rubber neck, & don't go slow in the left lane. 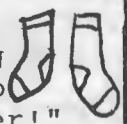

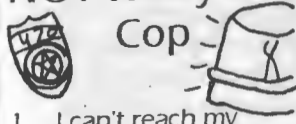

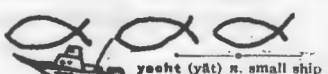
