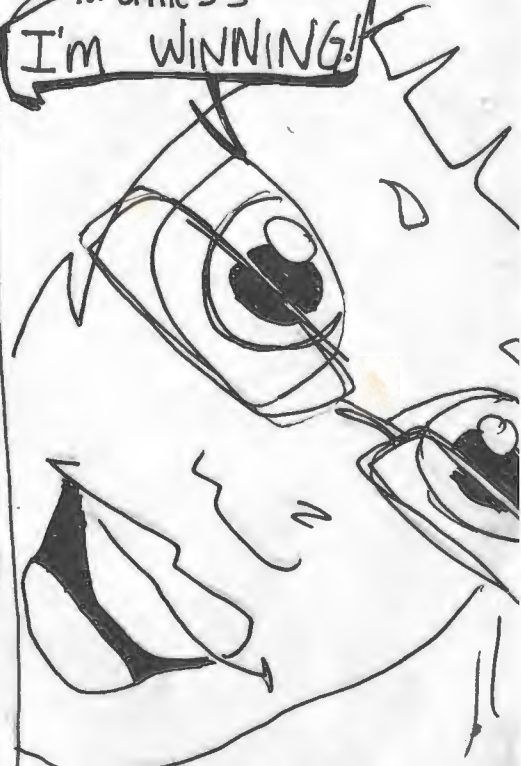

# Law of Gravity

## Bongs!

Whether it's a fancy store bought contraption or just a homemade job, gravity bongs are always a special treat. I still remember the first time I ever saw one. It was a fancy store bought kind... a four-foot glass cylinder with another slightly smaller one inside held in place with a rubber stopper. There was a removable bowl piece at the top & we had to stand on the coffee table just to hit it. At first, the concept eluded me... where was I supposed to put my mouth? The bowl blocked the only feasible opening. But then I realized it worked like an experiment I'd seen on Mr. Wizard when I was a kid. Mr. Wizard filled a sink w/ water then lowered the open end of an empty glass into the basin without tilting it so the air couldn't escape. When he slowly pulled the glass back up the air pressure created such suction most of the water remained in the glass. It's the same principle only add a small hole & a bowl piece. The suction pulls the smoke into the chamber when you pull the inner cylinder up then forces it out into your lungs when you push it back down. What a rush! It's like giving yourself a shotgun.

Well this was a buzz I came to love. Especially when I figured out how easy it was to make them at home. It's an art form really, making your own gravity bong. My brother was always fond of a 3-liter soda bottle & a bucket. Those are good power hits but hard to pass around & usually pretty messy. A 2-liter in the sink is easier to clean up but impossible to pass around. It's a nice party trick. My personal favorite was always the 20 oz. in a big cup. A decent sized hit, easy to pass & easier to hide if the occasion rises.

The bowl piece is the tricky part but with the right equipment it can be easily remedied. I've seen people just use tin foil which is effective but not recommended. The aluminum taste is pretty nasty & it's not good to take into your lungs, same as smoking out of a can. The easiest way is to use a sneak-a-toke (also called a bullet). A little bowl w/ a rubber stopper for a mouthpiece & a cap that screws on over the bowl. Conveniently the stopper fits perfectly in the mouth of a 20 oz. or 2 l. bottle & pulls off easily to take a hit. Another alternative is to cut a hole in the bottle's cap just big enough for an existing bowl head to fit in. It doesn't matter if it's a whole slide or just one that screws on.

The key to the perfect gravity bong hit though is how you fill it. Everyone has their own style, whether it's a quick jerk or a slow stroke. Just don't push the bong back down with out taking the bowl off. Remember that up pulls air in & down pushes it out. If you leave the bowl on your water will be full of weed & ash. Also, stale hits can be lethal. Go ahead & let that little puff go if it's taking you a while to fill the bottle, you'll regret it if you don't. It can be tricky at first but keep practicing. It's worth it!



## Cannabis milk

1. Put milk (soy or dairy) and cannabis into a double boiler
2. Cook on medium heat for half an hour, stirring often
3. Strain cannabis from milk and discard
4. Store milk in an air tight container in the fridge



## Wake and Bake Cakes

These pancakes are fantastic served with cannabis margarine and maple syrup.

### Ingredients

- 1/4 cup flour
- 2 tablespoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- pinch of cinnamon
- 2 tablespoons of oil
- 1/2 cup water
- 3/4 cup cannabis milk

### Method

1. Pre-heat griddle or frying pan while making the pancake batter. Do this over medium high flame.
2. Put all of the dry ingredients into a large bowl and mix thoroughly
3. In a separate bowl combine wet ingredients. Mix well.
4. Pour the wet mixture into the dry and blend. Minimal stirring is required, and the batter should be somewhat lumpy. This makes the pancakes light and fluffy. If you beat the batter smooth, your pancakes will be tough n' chewy.
5. Oil griddle slightly - pour batter. Flip the pancakes when the surface bubble up. You may need to lower the heat a little to keep the pancakes from burning, but the higher the heat, the lighter the pancakes.

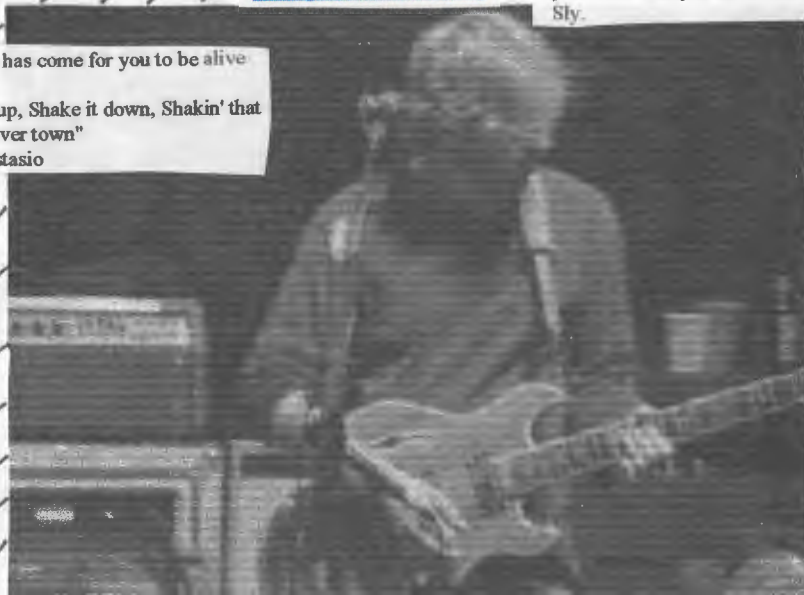
### True Story #2

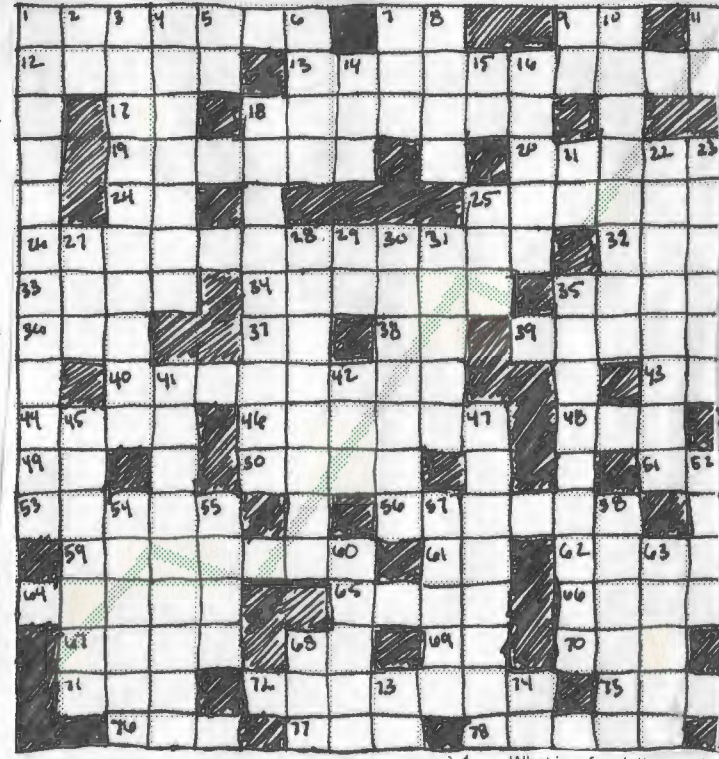

**Big Business' Big Plans for Big Bucks**

Ben Cohen schemes to "increase profits" by supporting a cop-killer. Cohen's claim that he took this position as a concerned citizen, not as an officer of any company, is an outright lie. As for "City of God", see below: The following quatrain has been circulating the internet after the WTC bombings.

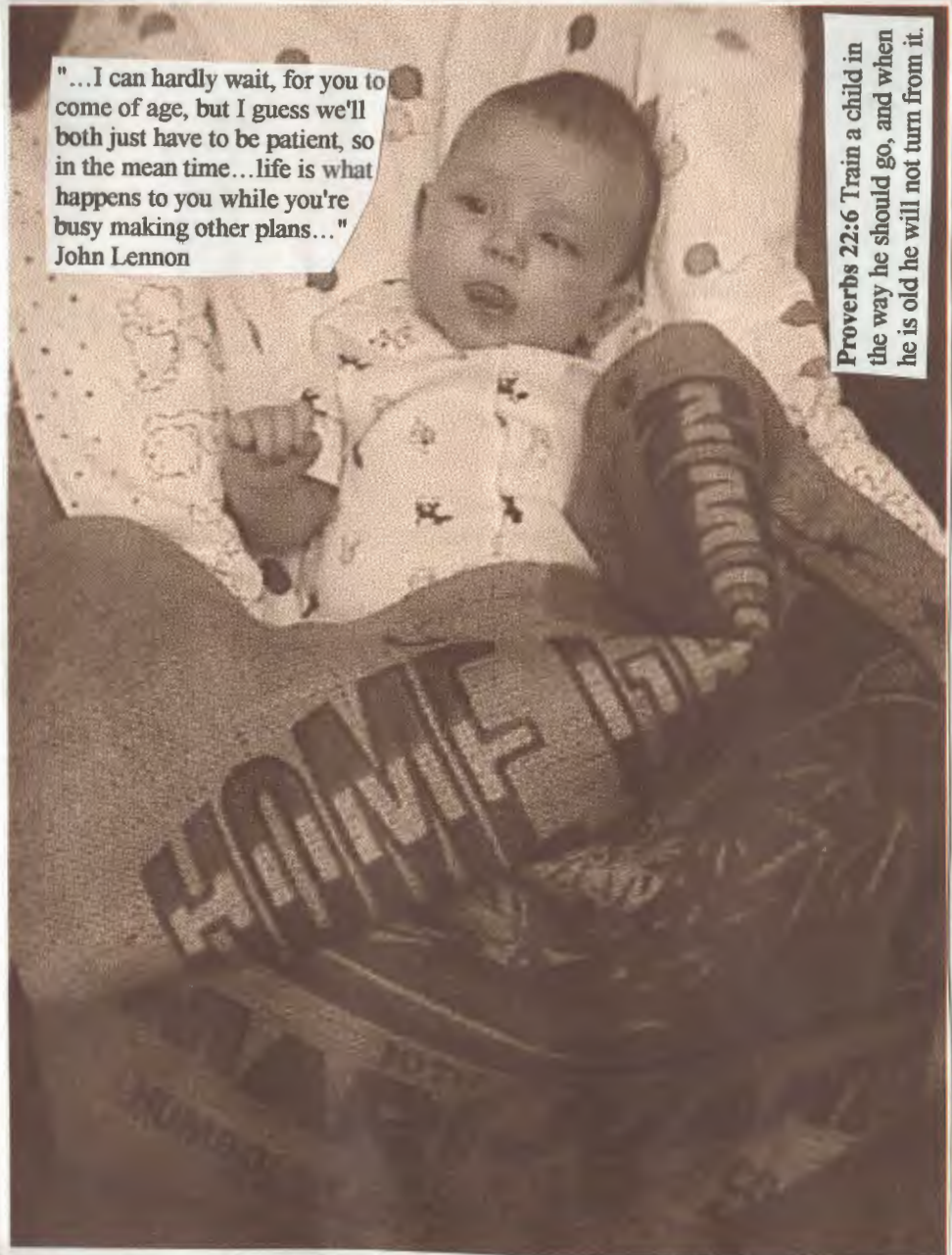
In the City of God there will be a great thunder,

TRIBUTE TO THE UNITED STATES

Widespread but only partial news coverage was given recently to a remarkable editorial broadcast from Toronto by Gordon Sinclair, a Canadian television commentator. What follows is the full text of his trenchant remarks as printed in the Congressional Record: "This Canadian thinks it is time to speak up for the Americans as the most generous and possibly the least appreciated people on all the earth.
