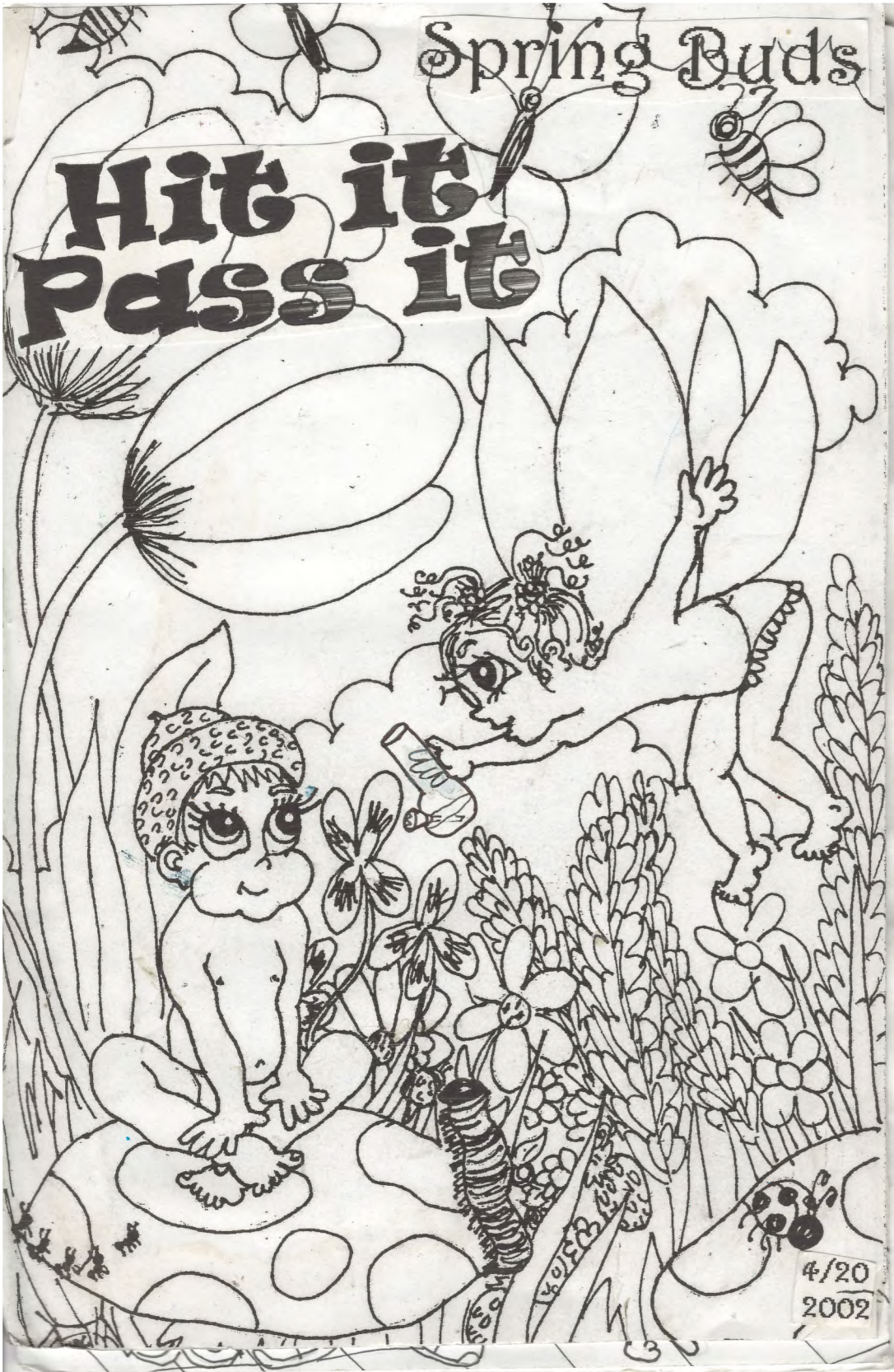

Save Your Smoke!

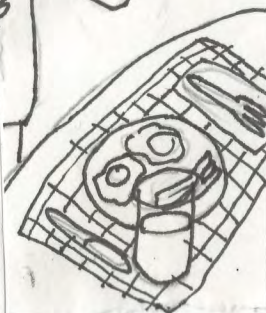

Banana Bread

- 1/2 oz. Marijuana (finely chopped)
- 1/2 cup Butter
- 1 1/4 cup Sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 2 Bananas (ripe ones)
- 1/3 cup Milk
- 2 tsp Vanilla
- 2 cups Flour
- 1 tsp Baking Soda

Preheat oven to 350 F

Follow the directions for Cannabis Butter except that you leave in the Cannabis. Cream Cannabis Butter and sugar. Add eggs. Beat it all well. Mash up the bananas. Stir them into the bowl. Mix milk and vanilla in a cup. Sift the flour and baking soda in a separate bowl. Add flour and milk to the butter bowl. Mix it all well. Spread evenly in a greased bread tin. Bake it for 1 hour, or until you can stick a toothpick in the middle, and it comes out clean. Let cool. Slice and butter. Mmmm...

The Art of Camouflage

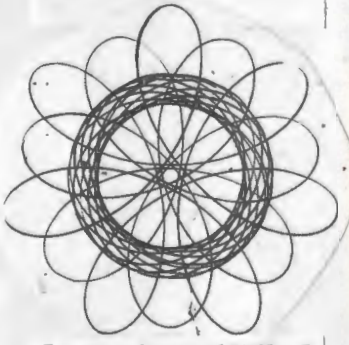

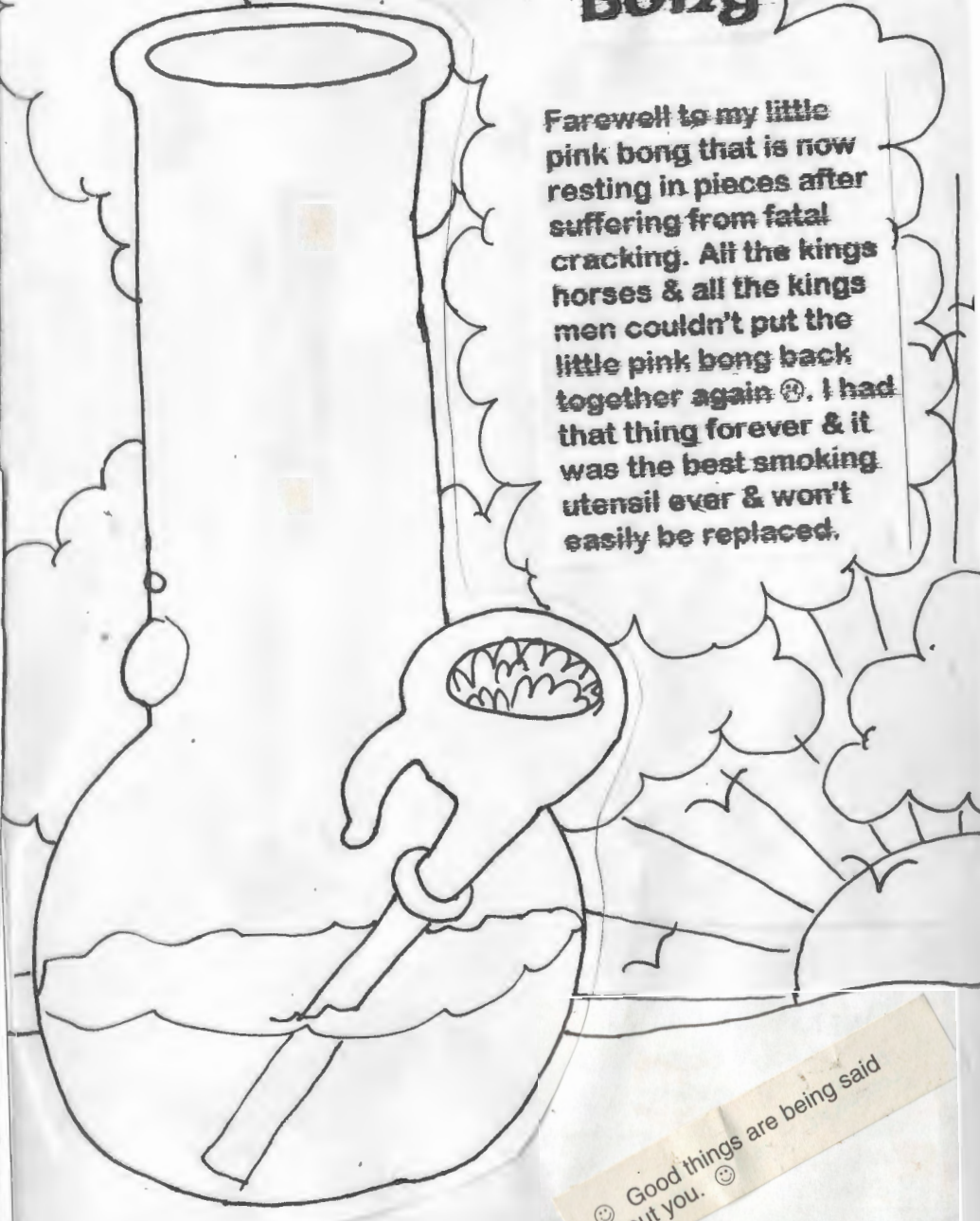
